

What is Move the Mission?

Move the Mission is a UPCI Youth Ministries effort by which funds are raised to support many different divisions within the United Pentecostal Church International. The UPCI Youth Ministries allocates Move the Mission monies each year to North American Missions, who then collectively offers church planters property and portable church equipment assistance.

What types of grants are available and how may the funds be used?

Portable Church Equipment grants are available and can be used to purchase portable (removable) church equipment from a reputable portable church equipment dealer. MTM Portable Church Equipment grants cannot be used to pay rent or a lease.

Property grants are available and can be used to remodel presently owned property, purchase property, purchase a building, or build new construction. MTM property grants cannot be used to pay rent or a lease. Property must be titled in the church's name. ***To apply for the MTM Property grant, please go back to the wa.upci.org/NAM home page and select the application MTM Property Grant.***

Where can I find a Move the Mission/NAM Applications?

Move the Mission applications are available through North American Missions online at www.northamericanmissions.faith ****NOTE**** Even though Move the Mission is a Youth Ministries campaign, applications are **ONLY** available through North American Missions.

When are Move the Mission/NAM applications due?

Move the Mission campaigns begin in the spring of each year. Applications are due to North American Missions by August 15th. This allows time for the application to be processed prior to being considered by the UPCI Youth Ministries at General Conference.

How does one apply for this financial support?

Applicants must fill out a Move the Mission/NAM application - completely and accurately for consideration. The church must be affiliated and the applicant must be a member of the United Pentecostal Church International. Also, the application must have the signatures of the District Superintendent, District North American Missions Director, and the District Youth President in the district where the church is located.

What is the maximum amount of funding available through a Move the Mission PCE grant?

A maximum of \$25,000.00 is available. Church planters are eligible to apply for up to three years from the church's established date.

What is the responsibility of my district in regard to my application?

The district Superintendent, Youth President, and NAM Director are responsible for reviewing, approving and signing the application.

What is required for the submission of an application?

The completed application, a clear updated picture of the church planter and family, and a copy of a detailed bid from a reputable portable church equipment dealer.
